

I feel the need to put a descriptor on each image, but to be honest, it'll be the same on them all.




Drawn with a bunch of 2B pencils (I now buy them in bulk) on 150gsm cartridge paper.

I'm slightly drunk.






I'm only a few pages in and have run dry on captions. Squiggly body parts? I'm doing my best. I never managed to capture the art world Zeitgeist on interesting titles.

the pose just doesn't pique my interest. Random body parts.... mainly hands, as they are quite interesting to draw, when






Nearly got the full figure in here, but much like Robespierre, I chopped the head off one of the figures. Perhaps they were guilty. I don't know.






I can't be bothered to caption this one.

It also depends on the day I've had. If I've had a bad day, I tend to draw better.
